- 1) **PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES / HALF-DAY on Thursday, 3/26!**
  - **ALL GRADES** must call to make appointments. Many time slots are booked! Call now!
  - **KIND. – 4th GRADE** appointments are available from 1 pm – 4:30 pm and 5:10 pm – 7 pm.
  - **MIDDLE SCHOOL** teachers are available from 1 pm – 5pm and 5:30 – 7:30 pm for one hour blocks during which families will see all teachers. The last appointment for M.S. starts at 6:30 pm.
