- 1) Thanks to everyone who attended **CURRICULUM NIGHT!** If you weren't able to make it, you are encouraged to contact your child's teacher for any informational handouts.
 - **PARKING** is continuously available at Casino in the Park in Lincoln Park (take second right after entering fountain roundabout from the east. The parking lot is on the left). You **MUST** display an LCCS permit on your dashboard while parked there. The attached permit can be printed out and used. Permits are also available at the main desk.
- 2) **DO NOT DOUBLE** or **TRIPLE PARK** or pause in front of the school on Kennedy Blvd. Turn right on Belmont and pause there to drop off your children. The parking situation in front of the school is dangerous and the Police Department, who has been very helpful so far, may start to ticket cars.
- 3) **LUNCH VOLUNTEERS** needed from **10:30 am – 12:30 pm** every day. Please come to the main office; no need to call ahead.
- 4) The **OCTOBER LUNCH CALENDAR** and order form are available at the front desk and the website - www.lccsnj.org, link to parents/Friday Flier,. Forms must be returned with payment (if required) by Wednesday, **9/30** to ensure lunch for your child on Thursday, **10/1**. Lunches are ordered in advance so we cannot accept orders on a daily basis. No extra lunches are ordered.
 - **NOTE:** For any student that wishes to have an extra milk or only milk, the cost is **\$0.25**. Money must be sent in with your child. *There will be no billing.*
