a. To approve the following charter amendment request:

WHEREAS, the mission of the Learning Community Charter School ("School") is operate as an independent public charter school dedicated to using an innovative integrated approach to achieve the intellectual, social, and emotional development of all students; and

WHEREAS, the School is delivering high quality education services to its students, evidenced in part by its students' performance on standardized tests; and

WHEREAS, the current maximum approved enrollment of the School is 585 students in each of the grades K through 8, for a total of 540 students; and

WHEREAS, there is currently excess demand for enrollment at the School, with 758 students on the lottery waitlist;

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Charter School Program Act requires that all charter schools seek enrollment of a cross section of the school age population in the community; and

WHEREAS, the School has capacity to serve additional students; and

WHEREAS, the School desires to provide a weighted preference to students who are duly identified as economically disadvantaged, to more broadly serve such students; and

WHEREAS, in recent years the United States and New Jersey Department of Educations have provided guidance on implementing weighted lotteries and the advantages therefrom; and

WHEREAS, an expansion of enrollment at the School, in addition to a weighted lottery favoring economically disadvantaged, would advance the mission of the School and the policies of New Jersey Charter School Program Act, which includes improving student education outcomes, accountability, choices and variety for students drawn from a cross section of the community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that

- 1. The School Administration be here hereby is authorized to file an application to the Commissioner of Education to amend the School's charter to increase its maximum approved enrollment by 54 students, from 585 to 639 effective the 2018-2019 school year and to institute a weighted lottery effective the 2018-2019 school year to favor economically disadvantaged students, in accordance with the School Administration letter dated October 26, 2017, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and
- 2. The School Administration be and hereby is directed to duly provide a copy of this application to the Jersey City Public Schools and take any and all actions in furtherance of this charter amendment application.
