NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Learning Community Charter School Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the School Leader to submit to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools in the County of Hudson an appropriate waiver of the requirements of N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-5.3 for the 2016-2017 school year.
